

## Report on inter Collegiate Technical Symposium Techaura 2019

The Department of Mechanical Engineering has been organizing intra and inter department technical symposium every year. Events were conducted through the four societies (SME, SAE, ASME & ISHRAE) functioning in the department. Competitions are conducted with focus on the various streams of mechanical engineering such as Design, Materials, Thermal and Manufacturing. These events are found to be useful to develop the leadership and team working skills among the students. The competition also inspiring the students to perform well in their academics. The necessary funds for the symposium was provided by the institution. Sponsorships were also received from companies collaborated with us.

This year the symposium was conducted on 14<sup>th</sup> March 2019. **Mr. JIBY ISAAC,** Head R&D, from Apollo Tyres Itd. attended the valedictory function and delivered keynote address.
