### BA DEGREE IN PUBLIC POLICY, WITH FORMER IAS, IPS OFFICERS AS MENTORS, IS BUILT FOR UPSC ASPIRANTS



A new three-year undergraduate degree in Public Policy where retired bureaucrats specially train you to take on various competitive exams and to understand what a life in public service entails. It was launched on Wednesday by Chennai-based Crescent Institute of Science and Technology. The course promises students an insider's view by getting on board retired or serving officials from Indian Administrative Services, Indian Police Services and Indian Administrative Services. Our university will be taking in 121 students this year and the intake may increase from the next academic year depending on the response. There is no entrance test, however, and applicants will have to give an interview. Even though the course is designed for students to appear for civil services, they are also allowed to sit for on-campus placements. The fee for the course differs on the basis of marks earned in the qualifying Class 12 examination.
