Nilavebu Kudineer distribution to the Staff and Students at the Crescent campus on 25th October 2019.

A total of 2,951 persons have been treated for dengue fever also known as breakbone fever in Tamil Nadu from January 2019. The state government and the Ayush Ministry pushing Nilavembu kudineer a Siddha medicine to combat prevent and manage all types of viral infections and fevers. Youth Red Cross (YRC) Society is a voluntary humanitarian organization having a network of over 700 branches throughout the country. The seven fundamental principles of YRC are Humanity, Impartiality, Neutrality, Independence, Voluntary Service ,Unity and Universality. All the students are the members of this society. The society focuses to promote life and health through training and education on safety, primary health care and healthy living, to encourage community service through training and education and to promote technical support for the development of youth programmes, fund-raising, identification of material and human resources.

Objectives

- To inculcate an awareness especially in relation to the care of their own health and that of others.
- To understand and acceptance of civic and human responsibilities.
- To cultivation and maintenance of a spirit of service and helpfulness to others.

Functioning

All the students of the Institute are the members of YRC. They are enrolled as members by paying Rs.10 per student to YRC, which collected along with admission fees. A portion of this amount Rs.4 per student as registration fee is remitted to Indian Red Cross Society, Tamil nadu Brach as per Government G.O. No:342, Department of Higher education dated 13.07.99.for enrollment.

The Institute has nominated two faculty member as a program officers to carry out the activities of the society. No hard and fast rules are laid down regarding Youth Red Cross activities. The programme should be adapted to the objective of the society.
