Award of Seed money to promote the Faculty/ student prjects 2021-22

B.S Abdur Rahman Crescent Institute of Science and Technology offers Seed money to all the faculty of the institute to take up small Research projects by themselves or by their students (both PG and Research) and submit the same for funding through proper channel for evaluation. The main Objective of the Crescent Seed Money Scheme is to encourage our faculty members/ research students to make them actively involved in the research activities and motivating the faculty members to apply for research grants to funding agencies. Our office helps not only to enhance the number of publications in the Scopus indexed journals but also to file their findings in the form of sponsored projects and Patents.

Applications were invited from the faculty and research supervisors for the year 2021-22. Our center (CSD and CSRIC) through a duly formed committee has arranged evaluation and based on the recommendation of the committee amount was sanctioned. The presentations were made by the faculties on 19-05-22, 25-05-22, 27-05-22 and 31-05-22 and 02-06-22. The committee members are,

Based on the experiments, it is anticipated that faculty will publish 39 HQ research papers, 16 file patents and also apply for 6 major funding from various Govt./ Non-Govt. agencies.

In this year a total of 40 proposals from faculties were received and the faculties made presentations before the committee on the research problems to be solved. After scrutiny, the committee has recommended to sanction 30 projects for funding. The expected outcome of the above sanctioned projects are 39 publications, 16 patents and 6 externally funded project proposals. The total cost of the Crescent Seed Money for the projects is Rs 9,05000/- . Earlier during 2019-20, the outcome of the seed money are 8 publications and 1 patent.

The seed money project order copy with Bank cheque are given on July 19th in seminar Hall 3 by Vice Chancellor, Dr.A.Peer Mohamed and our Registrar, Dr.N.Raja Hussain in the presence of Dean (Research) and other Senior Professors.
